

To all Stanbridge East Citizens



Following the adoption of the "*Règlement d'application de la Loi visant à favoriser la protection des personnes par la mise en place d'un encadrement concernant les chiens*" and in accordance with section 16 of the regulation, **any owner or guardian of a dog must register it with the municipality** of his or her primary residence within 30 days of the occurrence of one of the following circumstances, whichever date is closest:

- The acquiring of the dog; or
- Establishing your primary residence in the municipality; or
- The day the dog reaches the age of 3 months.

The registration fee, including the medal, is \$10 per dog.

**One-time charges for the life of the dog. (Resolution n° 20-07-14)*

PROCEDURE:

- 📄 Complete the form available at Town Hall (by appointment) or on the municipal website stanbridgeeast.ca;
- 📄 Send the form by email, mail or in person at the municipal office (by appointment);
- 📄 make the payment in cash (directly at Town Hall by appointment), by cheque (by mail or at town Hall with an appointment) Payable to *Municipality of Stanbridge East* or by direct payment via your financial institution.

All dogs must wear their medal at all times. Cost for replacing a lost or destroyed medal is \$5.00

Owners have the responsibility to notify the municipality of any changes.
