WE ARE LOOKING FOR BROME-MISSISQUOI FARMLAND OWNERS TO PARTICIPATE IN A UNIQUE NEW FARMLINK PROGRAM

Do you own land that has already been used for agricultural purposes in the past and which is currently lying fallow? Would you like to keep your cherished country landscapes? Would you like to make better use of your sugar bush, but you can no longer see how? If sustainable agricultural recovery in the region is close to your heart and you'd like to participate in this rebirth, here's how you can take action!

Brome-Missisquoi is developing, in collaboration with the GRAPP (French acronym for a group studying ways to protect countrysides and our local heritage) a land bank which matches aspiring farmers with landowners who wish to develop their land so that it is exploited to its full potential. The process, which started last year, has already created a twinning in Dunham and several other matches are in progress.

We are therefore looking for landowners and aspiring farmers in each of the 22 municipalities of the MRC. If you're in this situation or would like to know more, please contact us by email or phone.
