^{*} In addition to operating funds for the Sports Association and Municipal Library, this item also includes: the maintenance of all municipal lawns and playground equipment, electricity and maintenance for the ball field, tennis court and skating rink, the annual picnic and maintenance of the Community Centre (5 rue Academy).

Emptying of Septic Tanks

To be in conformity with the provincial government regulations concerning wastewater disposal systems (Q-2.r.8), in 2013 the municipality awarded a contract to Services Sanitaires G. Campbell Inc. to clean 201 septic tanks on the North side of the Municipality. The South side of Route 202 will be done in 2014. (Giroux, Memory Lane, Michel, Bunker, Gage, Gendreau, Nichols, Ridge, Ross, Sandy and the even civic #'s on route 202)

3-Year Program of Capital Expenditures

With the assistance of funds from the program "Transfert aux municipalités du Québec d'une partie des revenues de la taxe fédérale d'accise sur l'essence", the following road improvements were done in 2013:

- Paving rue Giroux and part of rue Michel
- Foundation section of chemin Gage
- Paving section of rue River

Repair to the Dam

Repairs to the dam scheduled for 2013 will be deferred to 2014 due to the high water level.

2014 Budget

The Municipal Council is currently working on the 2014 Budget and we will try to limit our expenses as much as possible, while still maintaining all of the services and facilities that make Stanbridge East a great place to live.
